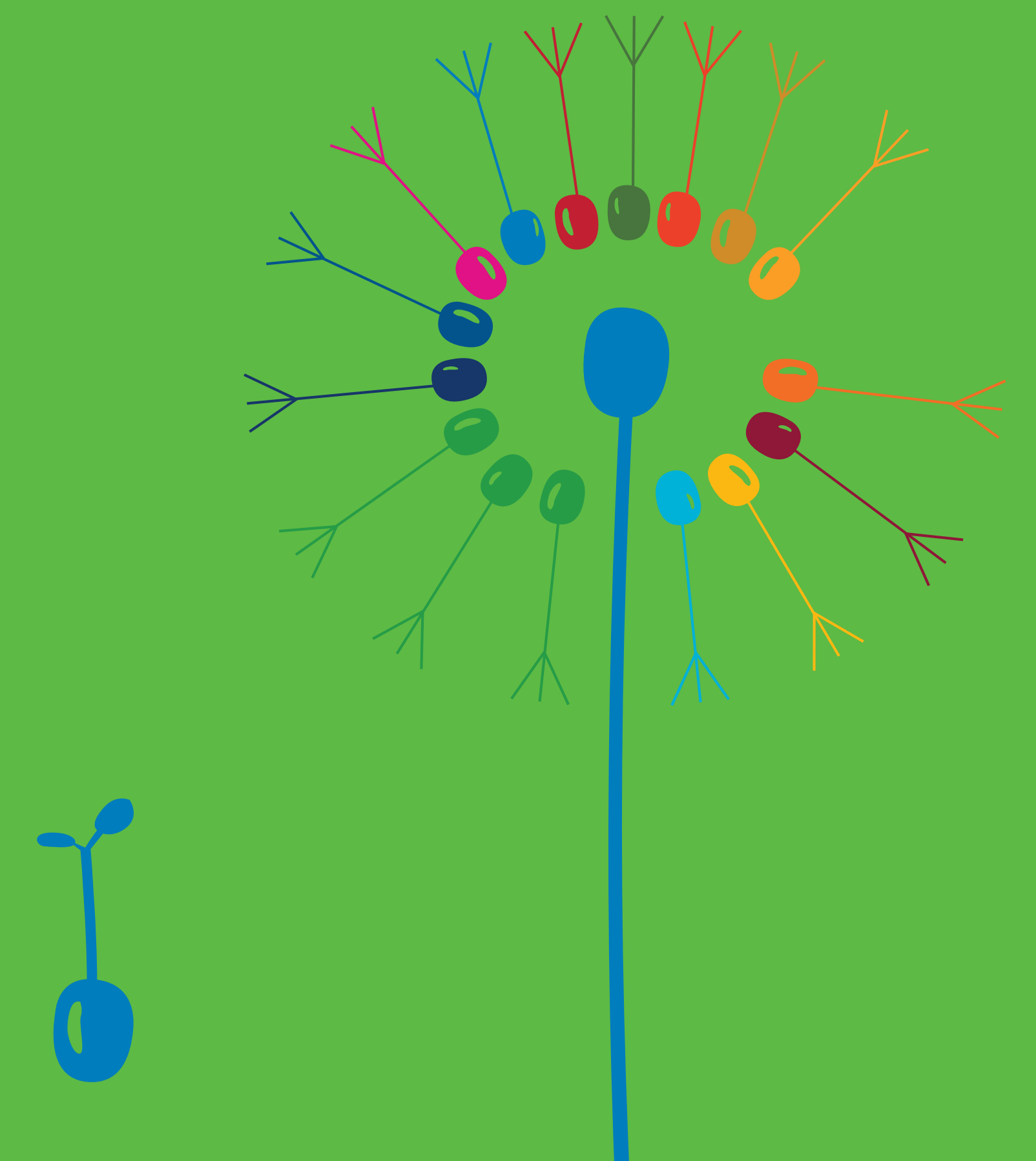

IP and the SDGs: Building our Common Future with Innovation and Creativity

Imagine you are a superhero, tasked with tackling one Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) Target of the 17 SDGs by 2030.

Create an art piece which depicts a superhero with his/her super suit/powers overcoming the challenges of one SDG target of your choice.

The art piece must be accompanied by a short description (no more than 200 words) on the SDG and your target. Participants additionally must explain how the superhero aims to overcome the challenges of the SDG target.

Example: SDG 7 - Ensure access to affordable, reliable, sustainable, and modern energy for all.

Target 7.3 - By 2030, double the global rate of improvement in energy efficiency.

Superhero: Elemento

Elemento is a superhero with extra-ordinary abilities to harness the elements of the earth within his body. He is able to harness water, air, fire/electricity, and the earth to distribute renewable energy resources to areas which are lacking. For example, Elemento harnesses the wind to drive wind turbines when trade winds are low to help generate renewable energy.

For children entering under the age of 8, parent/legal guardians and/or teacher can assist in writing this description.

All primary and secondary school students are allowed to enter their art pieces for the competition.

Participants may submit pieces to the ABIPCO Office at Hewlett House, St. John's Street, Street, St. John's, Antigua.

Submission of Art Piece and Entry Deadline: 4th November, 2024

To be eligible, only one entry per student is allowed. Your artwork may be 8.5 x 11 (letter size paper) or larger. It can be a painting, drawing, mixed collage, or an original digital design. Artwork can be any visual medium – pencil crayons, markers, water colour, acrylic, airbrush, or quick drying medium.

Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) represents a global blueprint for addressing some of the most pressing challenges facing humanity. With 17 goals and 169 targets, the SDGs aim to guide international efforts towards a more sustainable, equitable, and prosperous future for all.
